Re: Proposition 65 Statement

The state of California maintains and publishes a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. The list is administered by the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) and is updated at least once a year.

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals. These chemicals include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be by-products of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

Pinnpack certifies that their packaging products do not contain any of the latest OEHHA listed substances or are within the safe harbor level, if one has been adopted.
